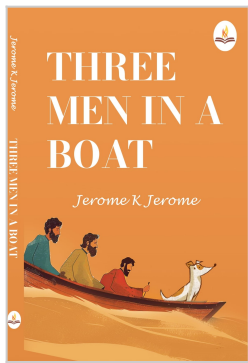

Jerome K. Jerome was an English writer best known for his humorous travel book *Three Men in a Boat*, inspired by a boating trip he took with friends on the Thames. Born in Walsall, England, Jerome faced poverty as a young man but found success with writing in his twenties. His other works include *Idle Thoughts of an Idle Fellow* and *Three Men on the Bummel*, a sequel to *Three Men in a Boat*. Despite continued writing, none matched his earlier success.

Three Men in a Boat by Jerome K. Jerome, is a humorous novel about a two-week boating trip on the Thames taken by three friends—Jerome, George, and Harris—along with a fictional dog named Montmorency. Initially meant to be a serious travel guide with historical facts, the book became more of a comedic adventure filled with witty observations and mishaps.
